Sapphire is the blue color variety of the mineral corundum. Other members of the corundum family include ruby and fancy sapphire (including padparadscha). One of the first known deposits of sapphire was found on the island of Ceylon (Sri Lanka). Presently, however, sapphires are recovered from a number of countries including Australia, Burma, Cambodia, China, India, Madagascar, Sri Lanka, Tanzania, Thailand and the USA, as well as elsewhere.
